

ORDINANCE NO. 2016-24

AN ORDINANCE
ESTABLISHING THE COMMUNITY WATER SYSTEM EMERGENCY FUND
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW LONDON, HURON COUNTY, OHIO, AS FOLLOWS

Section 1. That there is hereby established within the Village of New London the New London Community Water System Emergency Fund. The Fund shall be used for the deposit and expenditure of funds appropriated for response to emergency situations related to the Village water system, requiring immediate action by the Village, as required by Section 3745-85-01(D)(2), Ohio Administrative Code. All moneys allocated to this Fund shall be subject to further appropriation and expenditure as may be authorized or approved by this Council and/or according to law. The Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized and directed to take all administrative actions necessary to establish this Fund.


Section 2. Funds allocated to the Community Water System Emergency Fund may be expended at the direction of the Village Administrator in amounts not to exceed \$50,000; in the absence or unavailability of the Administrator, amounts not to exceed \$25,000.⁰⁰ may be expended at the direction of the Water Superintendent or Utility Foreman. Such expenditures shall be made only for an emergency situation which threatens the Village's ability to conduct its water system (such as fire, tornado, blizzard, hazardous material dump, or power outage) and which is consistent with the description and requirements set forth in the Village's Water System Contingency Plan.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, and for the welfare of the citizens of the Village, and for the further reason that it is necessary that this measure apply as soon as possible to assure that the Village remains in compliance with State Regulations, and that, provided it receives the majority vote of two-thirds or more of those elected to Council, this Ordinance shall therefore take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage, and otherwise it shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
