

ORDINANCE NO. 2016 - 29

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 2007-12 TO AUTHORIZE THE VILLAGE TO CARRY OUT CREDIT CARD SERVICES THROUGH SUTTON BANK, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW LONDON, HURON COUNTY, OHIO, AS FOLLOWS

Section 1. That Section 2 of Ordinance No. 2007-12 be, and hereby it is, amended to read as follows:

Section 2. That the ~~Clerk-Treasurer~~ **FISCAL OFFICER** and the Mayor be, and hereby they are, authorized and directed to enter into an Agreement with ~~National City Bank~~ **PNC BANK AND/OR SUTTON BANK, AT THE DISCRETION OF THE FISCAL OFFICER**, as the financial institutionS through which the Village will process payments by financial transaction devices, in accordance with that institution's standard terms, conditions, fees, and charges, current copies of which are on file with the Clerk-Treasurer; and the related transaction fees and expenses assessed by that institution will be charged by the Village as a surcharge or convenience fee.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, and for the welfare of the citizens of the Village, and for the further reason that it is necessary to that this measure become effective immediately in order to allow the Fiscal Officer to implement this change at the earliest possible time, and that, provided it receives the majority vote of two-thirds or more of those elected to Council, this Ordinance shall therefore take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor, and otherwise it shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
