

AN ORDINANCE  
AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO  
DISPOSE OF A MANURE SPREADER WHICH IS NO LONGER NEEDED FOR PUBLIC  
PURPOSES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW LONDON, HURON COUNTY,  
OHIO:

Section 1. That this Council hereby finds and determines that the following equipment is no longer needed for continuing municipal purposes and that the same may be sold: a manure spreader, otherwise identified as: Field Gymmy.

Section 2. The equipment described in Section 1 shall be sold at internet auction through "govdeals.com," or a comparable internet site, according to the following procedures, subject to the determination of and administration by the Village Administrator:

- a. bidding shall be permitted for a period of at least ten calendar days.
- b. bidding shall be conducted in accordance with the auction site's standard terms and conditions.
- c. the Administrator shall establish a minimum bid price for the equipment, as well as any other pertinent terms, including requirements for pick-up or delivery, method of payment, and any taxes or fees. This type of information shall be provided on the internet at the time of the auction. Such sale shall expressly be on an "as is" basis, disclaiming any warranties or representations of any kind to the fullest extent allowed by law.

The Administrator shall cause to be published in a newspaper of general circulation, notice of the Village's intent to sell unneeded, obsolete, or unfit municipal personal property by internet auction. The notice shall include a summary of the information provided in this Ordinance and shall be published twice. The second notice shall be published not less than ten nor more than twenty days after the previous notice. A similar notice also shall be posted continually throughout the calendar year in a conspicuous place in the offices of the Fiscal Officer, as well as on the Village's website. The Administrator is authorized and directed to sell the equipment to the highest and best bidder, and to execute such documents and perform such other things as may be necessary to accomplish said disposition.

Section 3. Proceeds from the sale of this equipment shall be credited to the following Fund(s): 5201-Sewer Fund.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, and for the welfare of the citizens of the Village, and for the further reason that it is necessary that this measure apply as soon as possible to assure that funds from this sale are available for anticipated current expenditures, and that, provided it receives the majority vote of two-thirds or more of those elected to Council, this Ordinance shall therefore take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage, and otherwise it shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
