A RESOLUTION

TO ADOPT THE SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT PLAN FOR THE HURON COUNTY SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT DISTRICT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS; the Village of New London is located within the jurisdiction of the Huron County Solid Waste Management District.

WHEREAS; the District Policy Committee prepared and adopted a final draft of the Solid Waste Management Plan in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Sections 3734.53, 3734.54 and 3734.55.

WHEREAS; the District has provided a copy of the Draft Final Solid Waste Management Plan for ratification to each of the legislative authorities of the District.


WHEREAS; the Village of New London, Huron County, Ohio must decide whether it approves of said Solid Waste Management Plan within ninety days of receipt of the Final Draft Plan.


NOW, Therefore, Be it Resolved by the Council of the Village of New London, Huron County, Ohio:

1. The Village of New London, Huron County, Ohio either:
 - a. approves the District Solid Waste Management Plan; or
 - b. disapprove the District Solid Waste Management Plan
2. The Clerk is hereby directed to send the District a copy of this resolution to the attention of Mr. Pete Welch, District Coordinator, Huron County Solid Waste Management District, 180 Milan Avenue, Norwalk, Ohio 44857

That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council of the Village of New London concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council of the Village of New London and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Sections 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
