

ORDINANCE NO. 2017 - 26

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF PUBLIC FUNDS FOR EXPENSES ARISING IN CONNECTION WITH THE GUN RAFFLE SCHEDULED FOR NOVEMBER 4, 2017, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

Whereas, the Friends of the New London Parks will be conducting a Gun Raffle on November 4, 2017, to generate funds for the benefit of the New London Parks, which event will require access to an advance of funds to acquire prizes and related materials; and

Whereas, the Village has funds on deposit in the Parks & Recreation Fund which are not restricted as to use, which are not presently needed for immediate Village requirements, and which could be used now to assist in the funding of this event; and

Whereas, all funds advanced shall be reimbursed to the Village within thirty (30) days following the event; Now, Therefore,


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW LONDON, HURON COUNTY, OHIO, AS FOLLOWS

Section 1. That the Village Fiscal Officer be, and hereby she is, authorized and directed to expend a total sum, not to exceed \$15,000.00, for the acquisition of prizes and related materials for the Gun Raffle to be conducted by the Friends of the New London Parks on November 4, 2017; funds for the payment of these expenses shall be paid from the following account(s): Parks and Recreation.

Section 2. That this Council hereby authorizes, directs, ratifies, and approves, this temporary advancement of funds, not to exceed a total of \$15,000.00, by the Fiscal Officer, with the express understanding and direction of this Council that all funds so advanced shall be reimbursed within thirty (30) days after the event. The Fiscal Officer shall advise the Council at such time as these funds have been reimbursed.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, and for the welfare of the citizens of the Village, and for the further reason that it is necessary to that this measure become effective immediately in order to allow the funds necessary to conduct the Gun Raffle on November 4, 2017, and that, provided it receives the majority vote of two-thirds or more of those elected to Council, this Ordinance shall therefore take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor, and otherwise it shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
