

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 131.11 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES RELATIVE TO FIRE DEPARTMENT FEES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW LONDON, HURON COUNTY, OHIO, AS FOLLOWS

Section 1. That Section 131.11 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of New London, as previously amended by Ordinance 2017-15, is hereby amended to read as follows:

131.11 FEES FOR SERVICE; BILLING PROCEDURES; PROCEEDS; EXCEPTIONS.

(a) Fees. The following fees shall be chargeable for emergency services provided by the Village Fire Department in connection with response to hazardous materials or injury accident calls:

- (1) for each emergency vehicle responding: **\$107.50** ~~100~~ per hour / per vehicle;
- (2) for each member of the Fire Department responding: **\$16.20** ~~12.00~~ per man-hour.

(b) Billing Procedures. The Clerk-Treasurer and the Fire Chief of the Village are hereby authorized to establish the billing procedures for the provision of such emergency services as specified in section "a" above.

(c) Proceeds. Proceeds from emergency service fees shall be deposited as follows:

- (1) For responses to fire calls: 75% to the Fire Fighting Facilities Fund and used as determined by Council, and 25% to the **POLICE AND FIRE FUND** ~~General Fund~~.
- (2) For general service calls: 55% to the Fire Fighting Facilities Fund and used as determined by Council, and 45% to the **POLICE AND FIRE FUND** ~~General Fund~~;
- (3) For Hazardous Materials calls: to the Fire Fighting Facilities Fund and used as determined by Council.


(d) Effective Date. The fees charged under this Section shall apply to emergency services provided to all persons on and after June 10, 2003.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, and for the welfare of the citizens of the Village, and for the further reason that it is necessary to that this measure become effective immediately before any fees are assessed or expended as specified by these amendments, and that, provided it receives the majority vote of two-thirds or more of those elected to Council, this Ordinance shall therefore take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor, and otherwise it shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
