

ORDINANCE NO. 18- 16

AN ORDINANCE  
ESTABLISHING THE FIRE DEMOLITION FUND, AMENDING THE 2018 ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS  
ORDINANCE TO MAKE APPROPRIATIONS OF REVENUES TO BE RECEIVED INTO THAT FUND, AND  
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW LONDON, HURON COUNTY, OHIO, AS  
FOLLOWS

Section 1 That there is hereby established within the Village of New London the New London Fire Demolition Fund. The fund shall be used for the deposit of funds received from insurers as deposits to assure the rehabilitation of fire-damaged structures, as specified in Ohio Revised Code Section 3729.86, and Section 1307.08 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of New London. Moneys allocated to this Fund shall be used to fund private property fire damage expenses incurred by the Village, and for reimbursement to the property owner upon completion of required repairs. All moneys allocated to this Fund shall be subject to further appropriation and expenditure as may be approved by this Council and/or according to law. The Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized and directed to take all administrative actions necessary to establish this Fund.

Section 2. To provide for revenues and expenditures during the course of fiscal year 2018, relative to insurance proceeds on deposit with the Village for damage to private property, the following unappropriated funds are hereby set aside and appropriated, for anticipated expenses:


Additional revenues: \$2,000.00 into the New London Fire Demolition Fund.

Section 3. The Fiscal Officer is authorized to draw warrants on the Village Treasury for the amounts appropriated in this ordinance, in accordance with State law, whenever claims are properly presented for which the indebtedness was incurred.

Section 4. The Council finds and determines that all formal actions relating to the adoption of this Ordinance have been taken at open meetings of this Council; that the deliberations of this Council and its Committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public in compliance with all statutory requirements, including the requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 5. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to bear emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the Village and for the further reason that it is necessary to appropriate these funds so funds submitted to the Village may be accounted for and disbursed according to law, and that, provided it receives the majority vote of two-thirds or more of those elected to Council, this Ordinance shall therefore take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor, and otherwise it shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
