

RESOLUTION NO. 2018 - 08

A RESOLUTION
DIRECTING CSX TRANSPORTATION, INC., TO IMMEDIATELY REPAIR
THE CROSSING OF ITS RAIL LINE ALONG WEST MAIN STREET (SR 162) AND
NORTH MAIN STREET (SR60),
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

Whereas, pursuant to Revised Code Section 4955.20, companies operating railroads in this State have an express statutory duty to. **“build and keep in repair good and sufficient sidewalks on both sides of streets intersected by their railroads, the full width of the right of way owned, claimed, or occupied by them”**; and

Whereas, Section 4955.20, authorizes this Council to compel railroads to comply with such duty; and

Whereas, the rail crossings along West Main Street and North Main Street operated by CSX Transportation, Inc., have been the subject of repeated complaints and are in immediate need of repair;

Whereas, on April 10, 2017, this Council enacted Resolution No. 2017-02 (Exhibit “A”), directing CSX to make such repairs; and

Whereas, on or about April 21, 2017, CSX was requested to take action in response to this Complaint (Exhibit “B”); and

Whereas, on May 3, 2017, CSX acknowledged receipt of the Village’s complaint (Exhibit “C”); and

Whereas, on May 8, 2017, the Village provided CSX with photographs of the sidewalks in need of repair, which are jeopardizing the ability of disabled individuals to traverse the right of way areas (Exhibit “D”); and

Whereas, in the past year, the Village has made repeated attempts to engage CSX in resolving these dangerous sidewalk conditions (Exhibit “E”); and

Whereas, the Village even found a contractor willing to implement the sidewalk changes required (Exhibit “F”), and CSX acknowledged receipt of the same (Exhibit “G”); yet, CSX has still failed to implement the needed repairs (Exhibit “H”); and

Whereas, both the Ohio Rail Development Commission and the Ohio Department of Transportation have been made aware of this problem, but neither has intervened to compel CSX to effect the repairs which are CSX’s legal obligation (Exhibit “I”); and

Whereas, Ohio Revised Code Section 4955.22 provides as follows:

4955.22 Failure to construct or repair crossings or sidewalks; forfeiture

A railroad company which neglects to comply with sections 4955.20 and 4955.21 of the Revised Code is liable to pay damage to the municipal corporation or township in which the highway is situated in the sum of thirty dollars for such neglect, and a further sum of ten dollars per day for each day such company fails to comply with the terms of such sections, to be recovered in an action brought in the name of the municipal corporation or township. The prosecuting attorney of the county shall prosecute to judgment any claim arising under such sections without charge to the municipal corporation or township.

and

Whereas, Ohio Revised Code Section 5561.16 provides, in pertinent part, as follows:

5561.16 Cost to be borne by company; notification; cost

Any person, firm, or corporation operating a railroad for the transportation of passengers, freight, or express, crossing at grade any street or road, shall construct, reconstruct, improve, maintain, and repair that portion of the highway at such crossing and lying between the outside ends of the ties, and also that portion lying between the tracks, in the case of two or more tracks, and the cost and expense of this construction, reconstruction, improvement, maintenance, or repair shall be borne by said individual, firm, or corporation. Such construction, reconstruction, improvement, maintenance, or repair shall be done in accordance with plans, profiles, and specifications first approved by the director of transportation, in case of state highways or extensions thereof, or by the county engineer, in case of county and township roads or extensions thereof.

Such individual, firm, or corporation, upon being notified by the director, in case of state highways or extensions thereof, or the engineer, in case of county or township roads or extensions thereof, that he has determined that it is necessary that such individual, firm, or corporation make such improvement, and being informed of the character thereof in a general way, shall, within thirty days from receiving such notice, which shall be served by the sheriff in the same manner as summons in civil action, prepare and submit to the director or engineer for his approval, detailed plans and specifications covering such improvement. The director or engineer may approve such plans and specifications as submitted, or he may change such plans and specifications and approve them as changed. Within thirty days after the approval of such plans by the director or engineer, such individual, firm, or corporation shall proceed to make such improvement, in accordance with the plans and specifications approved, and complete it in a reasonable time.

and

Whereas, the Ohio Supreme Court has opined that the Village may not compel a railroad to install a particular type of crossing on a state highway without the plans therefor having been approved by the Ohio Department of Transportation; Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW LONDON, HURON COUNTY, OHIO, AS FOLLOWS

Section 1. That, pursuant to Revised Code Section 4955.20, this Council hereby directs CSX Transportation, Inc., to immediately take all steps necessary to permanently repair the grade crossings and related sidewalks and roadway of its rail line, as it intersects West Main Street and North Main Street within the Village of New London.

Section 2. That this Council hereby petitions Mr. Jerry Wray, the Director of the Ohio Department of Transportation, to exercise his authority under Revised Code Section 5561.16, to cause CSX to develop approved plans and to implement the necessary improvements to the sidewalks within the right of ways in the Village of New London, at its expense, without delay.

Section 3. That this Council hereby petitions Huron County Prosecutor James Sitterly, to exercise his authority under Revised Code Section 4955.22, and institute forfeiture proceedings against CSX for each day since May 3, 2017 that CSX has failed to repair the sidewalks within its right of way within the Village of New London.

Section 4. That this Council hereby petitions the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio to implement procedures for the enforcement of railroads' statutory obligation under Revised Code Section 4955.20 throughout the State of Ohio.

Section 5. That the Fiscal Officer is authorized and directed to provide certified copies of this Resolution to CSX Transportation, Inc., to the Ohio Department of Transportation, to the Huron County Prosecutor, to the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio, Ohio Representative Dick Stein, and Ohio Senator Gayle Manning.

Section 2. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, and for the welfare of the citizens of the Village, and for the further reason that it is necessary that this measure apply as soon as possible to obtain resolution of this safety hazard at the earliest possible time, and that, provided it receives the majority vote of two-thirds or more of those elected to Council, this Resolution shall therefore take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage, and otherwise it shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.



BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW LONDON, HURON COUNTY, OHIO, AS FOLLOWS


Section 1. That, pursuant to Revised Code Section 4955.20, this Council hereby directs CSX Transportation, Inc., to immediately take all steps necessary to permanently repair the grade crossing and related sidewalks and roadway of its rail line, as it intersects West Main Street within the Village of New London. The Solicitor is hereby authorized and directed to provide notice of this directive to both CSX Transportation, Inc. and the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio; and, in the event that CSX Transportation, Inc., does not immediately demonstrate a good faith effort to comply with this directive, the Solicitor is authorized and directed to institute such formal complaints or legal proceedings as may be necessary to compel compliance with this directive.

Section 2. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, and for the welfare of the citizens of the Village, and for the further reason that it is necessary that this measure apply as soon as possible to obtain resolution of this safety hazard at the earliest possible time, and that, provided it receives the majority vote of two-thirds or more of those elected to Council, this Resolution shall therefore take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage, and otherwise it shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.

Records of the Ohio PUCO indicate that you remain the owner of the rail line which passes through the Village of New London, Ohio, as it crosses Main Street. Our Mayor has attempted to confer with your representatives on multiple occasions with respect to the dangerous condition of sidewalks at this location, but has not had any satisfactory responses. Our Village Council has, therefore, directed me, as the Village Solicitor, to formally complain to the PUCO and, if necessary, to institute legal proceedings to resolve this situation.

The edge line striping on SR 162 requested below was completed on August 1, 2017.

We met on site in July to discuss possible guardrail or embankment to protect the drop-off from the roadway to the road side.

We determined that guardrail is not possible in this area because the guardrail posts would have to protrude from the ground too much, which would undermine the functionality of the guardrail.

We also determined that the preferred solution is to raise the surrounding ground up to match the elevation of the roadway, which had been raised over time to compensate for the periodic raising of the railroad tracks by the railroad.

At the meeting, I said I would analyze crashes at the crossing and look into possible safety funding to accomplish this. I ran crashes for the last 3 years (2014-2016), and our database reported zero crashes at that location. Due to the lack of recent crashes, a safety application does not seem feasible for funding this option.

Also, we regret to inform you that the ODOT does not have any funding available to perform roadside work in municipalities, nor do we know of any funding sources that you could apply for to accomplish this work, outside your own municipal funds.

We're very sorry that we cannot be of more assistance, but if you can think of any other countermeasures for this location, please let us know.

I believe the reason edge lines could not be painted is because there is curb on the approaches to the crossing – I may be remembering this incorrectly, however. The conversation was some time ago. Can you confirm why edge lines couldn't be applied at this location. Also, you will see in picture HPIM2744 attached that there is a drop off on the SE quadrant. Is there any way to get guardrail applied here?

Mayor,

I am happy to assist with any grade crossing safety concern, ODOT is the right entity with respect to the roadway/state route. Unfortunately we did not realize when we set up the diagnostic review for the grade crossing that New London did not have responsibility for this section of roadway. Otherwise ODOT would have been invited and likely the roadway issues would have had a speedier resolution. Perhaps it would be appropriate to have ODOT folks meet you at the intersection and you can discuss this directly with them? Let me know if this is how you would like to proceed.

My apologies for not updating you. ODOT informed me that they stripped the centerline of SR 162 through the crossing on 5/31/2017. Unfortunately they could not stripe edge lines; my understanding is that it would be contrary to standards for the roadway due to the presence of curbs, although my recollection of the reason could be flawed. It is possibly too soon to tell if the center line and the T-intersection sign that your people placed are helping but if you have noticed a difference I would like to hear about it.

This is the last information that I have from ODOT.

With respect to the sidewalk, I believe that because the sidewalk is a village responsibility the impetus for any improvements must come from the village. If the village was to approach ODOT for assistance I would be glad to lend whatever support I can. I believe I can provide some funding towards the railroad surface portion of the project and ODOT should be able to point you to other possible funding sources. It is likely that the village would need to have some funding share as well, but the amount would depend on what other sources you can come up with.



I do apologize for the delay in responding. It is taking me some time to catch up from my leave. However, I did receive a response from ODOT which I am pasting below:

After reviewing the report, we have the following recommendations.

1. Restrict SB Clinton St. traffic to right out only via lane use and "no left turn" signing. SR 162 eastbound could then be accessed via Akron Street to SR 60 south and vice-versa.



2. Stripe edge lines and centerlines on SR 162 as close to the railroad crossing as possible

We do not recommend installing guardrail as it is not warranted per the L&D manual.

I believe this response is incomplete and am reaching out to get more information. I believe from our field meeting that restricting left turns is not a practical solution, although I have no notes that specifically state this. Is it feasible to restrict left turns?

I will follow up with ODOT on the stripping and some other recommendations that were in my report and get back to you.
