

ORDINANCE NO. 2018 - 40

AN ORDINANCE  
ESTABLISHING THE WATER TOWER COLOCATION COOPERATION FUND  
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW LONDON, HURON COUNTY, OHIO, AS FOLLOWS

Section 1. That there is hereby established within the Village of New London the New London Water Tower Colocation Cooperation Fund. The Fund shall be used for the deposit and expenditure of funds appropriated for the cooperative purchase, construction, installation, and ongoing operation and maintenance of Antenna Equipment on the New London Water Tower, in cooperation with the Board of Commissioners for Huron County, the Board of Education of the New London Local School District, and the Firelands Ambulance Service. All moneys allocated to this Fund shall be subject to further appropriation and expenditure as may be authorized or approved by this Council and/or according to law. The Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized and directed to take all administrative actions necessary to establish this Fund.

Section 2. Funds allocated to the New London Water Tower Colocation Cooperation Fund may be expended at the direction of the Village Administrator in accordance with the Tower Antenna Cooperation Agreement entered into by the Village of New London with the Board of Commissioners for Huron County, the Board of Education of the New London Local School District, and the Firelands Ambulance Service.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the Village and for the further reason that it is necessary to implement the proposed antenna service as soon as possible to foster community emergency services, and that, provided it receives the majority vote of two-thirds or more of those elected to Council, this Ordinance shall therefore take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor, and otherwise it shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
