

AN ORDINANCE
AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT FOR A TOWER ANTENNA COOPERATION
AGREEMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of New London, Ohio currently owns a Water Tower ("Tower"), which it operates in connection with its public water utility; and

WHEREAS, the Tower may safely and expeditiously be used to accommodate the installation of a transmission and receiving antenna and related cabling and equipment; and


WHEREAS, various public entities in the New London community have similar needs which can economically be served by jointly participating in the installation and maintenance of antenna equipment on the Tower; Now, Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW LONDON, HURON COUNTY, OHIO, AS FOLLOWS

Section 1. That the Council hereby authorizes the Village Administrator to enter into an Agreement with the Board of Commissioners for Huron County, the Board of Education of the New London Local School District, and the Firelands Ambulance Service, for the cooperative purchase, construction, installation, and ongoing operation and maintenance of Antenna Equipment on the Tower in accordance with the terms, conditions, and specifications on file with the Village Administrator. The Administrator and Fiscal Officer are authorized to execute such documents and comply with such procedures as are necessary to implement the proposed project at the earliest possible time.


Section 2. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the Village and for the further reason that it is necessary to implement the proposed antenna service as soon as possible to foster community emergency services, and that, provided it receives the majority vote of two-thirds or more of those elected to Council, this Ordinance shall therefore take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor, and otherwise it shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
