

ORDINANCE NO. 2022 - 03


AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH DIRT DAWG EXCAVATING, LLC FOR THE NEW LONDON LEAD SERVICE LINE REPLACEMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW LONDON, HURON COUNTY, OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Village Administrator be, and hereby he is, authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with Dirt Dawg Excavating, LLC, of Ashland, Ohio, the lowest and best bidder, for the New London Lead Service Line Replacement project, at the total bid price of \$320,824.50, in accordance with plans and specifications prepared and on file with the Administrator, and that funds for this contract shall be paid from the following account(s): 5101 (Water). In authorizing this action, this Council hereby waives any and all informalities in the bid not involving price, time or changes in the Work, and expressly waives any irregularity with respect to the bid date listed on the bid guaranty and contract bond that was submitted with the bid of Dirt Dawg Excavating, LLC.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, and for the welfare of the citizens of the Village, and for the further reason that it is necessary that this measure become effective immediately because lead service lines create a potential risk to the health of water customers which should be eliminated with this replacement project at the earliest possible time, and that, provided it receives the majority vote of two-thirds or more of those elected to Council, this Ordinance shall therefore take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor, and otherwise it shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
