

**NEW LONDON VILLAGE COUNCIL**  
**Special Meeting – Monday, August 5, 2019 @ 7 p.m.**

Mayor John Martin called the meeting to order.

Roll call was then taken with the following members present: Curtis, Paramore, Cooke, Myers and Willis. Ball was absent.

Also present: Don Patton

John Martin then asked for approval of the agenda. Myers made a motion to approve the agenda. Curtis seconded the motion. Roll call - All ayes; No one opposed.

John Martin then asked for New Business.

Mayor John Martin asked council's permission to approve four new recreation committee members.

Bill Curtis made a motion to approve Marvin McCallister, Tina Goostree, Brittney Gullett and Mark Hinckley II as recreation committee members. Cooke seconded the motion. Roll call – All ayes; No one opposed.

Don Patton then read the following letter:

We are hiring to fill Ed Schoville's position. Ed has recently retired after being employed with the Village for 28 ½ years. Ed started on February 25<sup>th</sup>, 1991 along with Ted Williams on the same day. I want to take a moment to thank Ed for his years of service and wish him the best.

We have advertised and received 9 applicants for the position of Street and Sanitation. We called for 6 interviews and received 5 call backs. Through the interview process we came up with 1 preferred candidate and 2 alternates. We have completed background checks on all 3 of the applicants and they have all been cleared.

The preferred candidate is Dustin Woodrum from Wellington. He is a Firelands High School/ Lorain County JVS graduate. He studied Industrial Equipment and Mechanics at JVS. He currently is employed at Republic Services as a residential garbage truck driver. He holds a class B CDL.

His starting wage would be \$16.00 an hour, with a 3% increase after his 90-day probation period bringing his wage up to \$16.48 per hour.

I am asking councils permission to hire Dustin.


