

**NEW LONDON VILLAGE COUNCIL**  
**Special Meeting – Wednesday, August 14, 2019 @ 7 p.m.**

Mayor John Martin called the meeting to order.

Roll call was then taken with the following members present: Curtis, Paramore, Cooke, Myers, Ball and Willis.

Also present: Don Patton, Shawn Pickworth

John Martin then asked for approval of the agenda. Paramore made a motion to approve the agenda. Myers seconded the motion. Roll call - All ayes; No one opposed.

John Martin then asked for New Business.

Bill Curtis made a motion to accept the resignation of Heather Brown effective immediately. Willis seconded the motion. Roll call – All ayes; No one opposed.

Don Patton requested that council allow him to hire Clayton Englet as a new Street/Sanitation employee at a rate of \$12 per hour.

Bill Curtis made a motion to hire Clayton Englet beginning August 26, 2019 at a rate of \$12 per hour with a 3% increase after a successful 90-day probationary period. Ball seconded the motion. Roll call – All ayes; No one opposed.

Shawn Pickworth then asked council's permission to hire Kyah Durham as a seasonal employee to help in the reservoir office due to the resignation of Heather Brown. Kyah had worked in the office previously so he thought she would be a good addition.

Janice Myers made a motion to allow the Village Administrator to hire Kyah Durham as a seasonal recreation employee at \$10 per hour beginning August 15, 2019. Willis seconded the motion. Roll call – All ayes; No one opposed.

Stuart Cooke asked if they should decide what to do about the Campers Association discount.


