

AN ORDINANCE 2019-13

AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH
THE HURON COUNTY LAND REUTILIZATION CORPORATION

WHEREAS, the Huron County Land Reutilization Corporation ("HCLRC") has been organized for the purposes of exercising the essential governmental purposes provided for under Chapters 1724 and 5722 of the Ohio Revised Code and any ancillary purposes for which statutory authority has been given to the HCLRC under the Ohio Revised Code within Huron County (the "County"), including, but not limited to, the following purposes:

- 1) Facilitating the reclamation, rehabilitation, and reutilization of vacant, abandoned, tax-foreclosed or other real property within the county;
- 2) Efficiently holding and managing vacant, abandoned, or tax-foreclosed real property pending its reclamation, rehabilitation, and reutilization;
- 3) Assisting governmental entities, such as the City/Village/Township, and other non-profit or for-profit persons to assemble, clear, and clear the title of vacant, abandoned, tax-foreclosed or other real property within the County in a coordinated manner; and
- 4) Promoting economic and housing development of the county or region; and


WHEREAS, the Village and HCLRC are desirous of entering into an Agreement, whereby HCLRC can serve as the Village's agent, as authorized by Revised Code Section 715.261(E) in connection with removing, repairing, or securing insecure, unsafe, structurally defective, abandoned, deserted, or open and vacant buildings or other structures, making emergency corrections of hazardous conditions, or abating any nuisance, including high weeds, overgrown brush, and trash and debris from vacant lots; Now Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW LONDON, HURON COUNTY, OHIO, AS FOLLOWS


Section 1. That the Village Administrator be, and hereby he is, authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with Huron County Land Reutilization Corporation to serve as the Village's agent to perform services in the manner authorized and set forth in Ohio Revised Code Section 715.261.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
