

ORDINANCE NO. 2021 - 02

AN ORDINANCE  
AUTHORIZING A USDA – RURAL DEVELOPMENT WATER & ENVIRONMENTAL  
PROGRAM GRANT AND LOAN AGREEMENT WITH THE UNITED STATES  
DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW LONDON, HURON  
COUNTY, OHIO, AS FOLLOWS

Section 1. That this Council hereby approves, authorizes and agrees to enter into a USDA – Rural Development Water & Environmental Program Grant and Loan Agreement with the United States Department of Agriculture for the USDA Grant/Loan to proceed with and construct the Village’s Wastewater Treatment Plant improvements at an estimated total cost of \$3,059,000, such Grant/Loan, totaling \$3,048,000, to be in the amounts of an \$892,000 Grant and a \$2,156,000 Loan, and authorizes and agrees that the Mayor is authorized and directed to execute such Agreement; and that the Mayor, the Village Administrator, and the Superintendent of the Wastewater Treatment Plant are each, individually, authorized and directed to represent the Village and to take such actions as may be necessary and execute such documents as may be necessary to proceed with the proposed USDA Grant/Loan, in accordance with specifications on file with the Fiscal Officer.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to bear emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the Village and for the further reason that it is necessary to comply with time deadlines established for this proposed USDA Grant/Loan, and that, provided it receives the majority vote of two-thirds or more of those elected to Council, this Resolution shall therefore take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor, and otherwise it shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
