

ORDINANCE NO. 2020 - 10

AN ORDINANCE  
AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO AUCTION MISCELLANEOUS  
EQUIPMENT WHICH IS NO LONGER NEEDED FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW LONDON, HURON  
COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1. That this Council hereby finds and determines that the following  
equipment is no longer needed for continuing municipal purposes and that the same may be sold:

1. Chevy 1973 C65 (Old Jetter Truck) 336 V8 with 1969 4 cylinder gas pump motor, 400ft  
reel hose, 1000 gal. tank – Value \$999.00
2. 2002 Chevy S10, V6 Gas – Value \$500.00
3. 4 Fairbanks Scales – Value \$100.00 each.
4. Toledo Scales – Value \$100.00
5. 3 – 300 gal. fuel tanks w/pumps – Value \$200.00 each.
6. 100' of handrail – Value \$100.00
7. 1970 Tri Axle Trailer – Value \$400.00
8. 9'6" Western V-plow w/hardware – Value \$300.00
9. 1981 – 555 Ford Backhoe – Value \$999.00
10. 3 pt. Landpride finish mower – Value \$200.00

Said equipment shall be sold at public auction according to procedures established by the Village  
Administrator.


Section 2. Proceeds from the sale of this equipment shall be credited to the following
