ORDINANCE NO. 2020 - 32

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2020 ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS ORDINANCE
BY AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF CERTAIN FUNDS AND APPROPRIATIONS AS NEEDED FOR
OPERATIONS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act, 116 Public Law 136, (the “CARES Act”) was signed into law by the President of the United States on March 27, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the 133rd Ohio General Assembly (hereinafter "General Assembly") established a process for distributing funds provided by the “Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act” to local government “subdivisions”; and

WHEREAS, this Council heretofore enacted a Resolution 2020-04 affirming that funds from the County Coronavirus Relief Distribution Fund would be expended only to cover costs of the subdivision consistent with the requirements of section 5001 of the CARES Act as described in 42 U.S.C. 601(d), and any applicable regulations before receiving said funds; and

WHEREAS, such finds were heretofore provided to the Village pursuant to that Program; and

WHEREAS, the Village has now identified various expenditures already incurred by the Village for purposes that are authorized and may be expended from that Fund, details of which are on file with the Village Fiscal Officer, the same being: (1) necessary expenditures incurred due to the public health emergency with respect to the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19); (2) expenditures that were not accounted for in the Village of New London’s most recently approved budget as of March 27, 2020; and (3) expenditures that were incurred during the period that begins on March 1, 2020, and ends on December 30, 2020; Now Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW LONDON, HURON COUNTY, OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. To provide for expenditures during the course of fiscal year 2020, the following sums shall be, and hereby they are, transferred and appropriated within the funds as noted below:

Section 2. The Fiscal Officer is authorized to draw warrants on the Village Treasury for the amounts appropriated in this Ordinance, whenever claims are properly presented for which the indebtedness was incurred.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, and for the welfare of the citizens of the Village and for the further reason that it is necessary that this measure apply as soon as possible inasmuch as these financial obligations have already been incurred by the Village and that, provided it receives the majority vote of

two-thirds or more of those elected to Council, this Resolution shall therefore take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage, and otherwise it shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
