

ORDINANCE NO. 2020 – 05

AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE LOWEST AND BEST BIDDER FOR PHASE II – 250,000 GALLON ELEVATED WATER STORAGE TANK REHABILITATION PROJECT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW LONDON, HURON COUNTY, OHIO, AS FOLLOWS

Section 1. That the Village Administrator be, and hereby he is, authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with **D & M Painting Corporation**, the lowest and best bidder, at a bid price of **\$157,680.00**, for the Phase II – 250,000 Gallon Elevated Water Storage Tank Rehabilitation Project, in accordance with the plans and specifications already on file at the Village Hall. Funds for said contract shall be paid from the following fund(s): **Revolving Loan Fund**.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, and for the welfare of the citizens of the Village, and for the further reason that it is necessary to that this measure become effective immediately in order to proceed with this necessary project at the earliest possible time, and that, provided it receives the majority vote of two-thirds or more of those elected to Council, this Ordinance shall therefore take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor, and otherwise it shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
