

ORDINANCE NO. 2020 - 07

AN ORDINANCE
AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO PROCEED WITH THE LEASE OF TWO
NEW KUBOTA ZD1211 – 72 INCH MOWERS AND AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER
TO AUCTION TWO MOWERS WHICH ARE NO LONGER NEEDED FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES,
AND PROVIDING FOR AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE

Whereas, the Village is authorized under Section 125.04 of the Ohio Revised Code to make purchases from vendors directly and without competitive bidding when the vendor is willing to sell the same item at a price which is lower than is available under the State's bid process; and

Whereas, Tax-Exempt Leasing Corp. is offering to lease certain equipment at a price less than is available under the State's established bid price; Now, Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW LONDON, HURON COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Village Administrator be, and hereby he is, authorized and directed to enter into an Agreement with Tax-Exempt Leasing Corp., for the lease of two new Kubota ZD1211- 72 inch mowers, at "state bid" pricing as authorized by Section 125.04, Ohio Revised Code, and that he execute such documents and perform such other things as may be necessary to accomplish the same. The net monthly payment/Quarterly payment will be \$385.45/\$1,541.79, in accordance with the bid specifications and pricing on file with the Administrator. Funds for the acquisition of the truck shall be paid from the following fund(s): Recreation Fund.

Section 2. That this Council hereby finds and determines that the following equipment is no longer needed for continuing municipal purposes and that the same may be sold: two mowers, each valued at less than \$1,000, described as follows: Grasshopper Mowers. Said equipment shall be sold at public auction according to procedures established by the Village Administrator.


Section 3. Proceeds from the sale of this equipment shall be credited to the following Fund(s): Recreation Fund.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, and for the welfare of the citizens of the Village, and for the further reason that it is necessary to obtain the new equipment at the earliest possible time, and that, provided it receives the majority vote of two-thirds or more of those elected to Council, this Ordinance shall therefore take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage, and otherwise it shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
