

ORDINANCE NO. 2019 - 07

AN ORDINANCE
AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS FROM THE COMMUNITY
DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT REVOLVING LOAN FUND
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

Whereas, the Village has funds currently being held in the Community Development Block Grant Revolving Loan Fund which have not heretofore been used or required for any other lawful purpose; and

Whereas, the Village anticipates that funds will be needed for a variety of maintenance and repairs immediately needed for the Village Water Tower, (e.g., install new fill pipe; abrasive blast clean and new epoxy coating system of the tank; install fall prevention devices on all ladders per OSHA regulations; new interior lighting; install frost free pressure vacuum vent and seal existing ventilation around access tube; install new condensate platform with drain, new mud valve, and weld new fitting into over flow pipe; install new mixer to prevent water from freezing); and

Whereas, the State of Ohio Office of Community Development has authorized the use of CDBG Revolving Loan Funds for that purpose; Now, Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW LONDON, HURON COUNTY, OHIO, AS FOLLOWS

Section 1. To provide for Maintenance and Repairs to the Village Water Tower, the following sums are hereby appropriated:

From Fund: CDBG Revolving Loan Fund \$ 100,000.⁰⁰ ;

and the Village Administrator and Fiscal Officer are hereby authorized and directed to use such funds for the Village Water Tower Maintenance and Repairs project.

Section 2. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, and for the welfare of the citizens of the Village, and for the further reason that it is necessary to that this measure become effective immediately in order to proceed at the earliest possible time with the improvements to the Village Water Tower, and that, provided it receives the majority vote of two-thirds or more of those elected to Council, this Ordinance shall therefore take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor, and otherwise it shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
