

ORDINANCE NO. 15-03

**AN ORDINANCE
AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO
ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE HIGHEST BIDDER
FOR THE TEMPORARY AGRICULTURAL USE OF CERTAIN PUBLIC LANDS**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW LONDON, HURON
COUNTY, OHIO, AS FOLLOWS**

Section 1. That the Village Administrator is hereby authorized and directed enter into an agreement with Chris A. Clark, the highest bidder, for the temporary, lawful, agricultural use of certain lands owned by the Village but not presently needed for public purposes, and which land consists of 33.6 acres of land located at the New London Reservoir Park facility, and described in the specifications on file with the Village Administrator, at the following bid rates:

2015 - \$94.00/acre 33.6 acres = \$3158.40

2016- \$92.00/acre 33.6 acres = \$3091.20

2017 - \$90.00/acre 33.6 acres = \$3024.00

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
