

ORDINANCE NO. 2015 - 05

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE STATE COOPERATIVE SALT PURCHASING PROGRAM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

Whereas, Ohio Revised Code Section 5513.01 authorizes the State of Ohio Director of Transportation to make purchases of necessary supplies and materials and, further, authorizes the Director to permit political subdivisions to participate in those contracts; and


Whereas, the Ohio Department of Transportation is providing political subdivisions the opportunity to participate in a Summer Salt Contract, and/or a Winter Salt Contract, to acquire and make road salt available for the 2015-2016 road maintenance seasons; Now, Therefore,


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW LONDON, HURON COUNTY, OHIO, AS FOLLOWS

Section 1. That the Council hereby authorizes the Village Administrator to enter into the State of Ohio Department of Transportation's Salt Contract purchasing program. The Administrator is authorized to enter into Agreements with the ODOT as may be necessary to participate in the Summer and/or Winter Salt Contracts, as the Administrator deems appropriate, in accordance with the standard State program. The Administrator and Fiscal Officer are authorized to execute such documents and comply with such procedures as are necessary to participate. Funds for said contract shall be paid from the following funds: **STREET AND STATE HIGHWAY FUNDS.**

Section 2. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, and for the welfare of the citizens of the Village, and for the further reason that it is necessary to that this measure become effective immediately in order to meet State deadlines for this program, and that, provided it receives the majority vote of two-thirds or more of those elected to Council, this Ordinance shall therefore take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor, and otherwise it shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
