Special Meeting – Wednesday, September 29, 2021 @ 5:00 p.m.

Toby Thomas called the meeting to order.

Roll call was then taken with the following members present: Gullett, Myers, Willis, Cooke and Steve Ball. Jennifer Ball was absent.

Cooke made a motion to approve and amend the agenda by adding Old Business. Myers seconded the motion. Roll call – All ayes; No one opposed.

Toby Thomas presented Ordinance 2021-37 An Ordinance Amending the 2021 Annual Appropriations Ordinance to Make Appropriations for Certain Expenses and Declaring an Emergency. Emergency Reading. Steve Ball made a motion to allow Ordinance 2021-37 to be passed on an emergency measure. Willis seconded the motion. Toby Thomas presented Ordinance 2021-38 An Ordinance Authorizing the Village Administrator to Make Public Utilities Available to Permanent Parcel No. 26021B010110500, and Declaring an Emergency. Toby Thomas presented Ordinance 2021-40 An Ordinance Authorizing a Memorandum of Understanding Between the Village of New London and the Board of Education of the New London Local School District for Engaging a School Resource Officer for the 2021-2022 School Year, and Declaring an Emergency. Emergency Reading. Steve Ball made a motion to allow Ordinance 2021-40 to be passed on an emergency measure. Willis seconded the motion. Toby Thomas then presented Ordinance 2021-41 An Ordinance Amending Section 123.01 of the Codified Ordinances, Relative to the Fiscal Officer. First Reading. Cooke made a motion to approve the first reading. Myers seconded the motion. Roll call – All ayes; No one opposed.

Toby Thomas then presented Resolution 2021-10 A Resolution Accepting the Amounts and Rates as Determined by the Budget Commission and Authorizing the Necessary Tax Levies and Certifying them to the County Auditor. Emergency Reading. Myers made a motion to allow Resolution 2021-10 to be passed on an emergency measure. Cooke seconded the motion. Roll call: Jennifer Ball, Absent; Cooke, Yes; Myers, Yes; Willis, Yes; Steve Ball, Yes; Gullett, Yes. Cooke made a motion to approve the emergency reading. Willis seconded the motion. Roll call – All ayes; No one opposed.

Toby Thomas then called for Old Business

Toby Thomas stated that he talked to Clint Cherry about closing down the road for special events. Clint Cherry doesn't think that the village parking lot will be large enough to hold the Halloween event. He told Toby Thomas that he will plan all of the events for 2022 at the beginning of the year and then submit them all at one time to council for approval. Clint Cherry also told Toby Thomas that the Rotary has asked him to

do what they did last year for Halloween. This will include a Jackolantern Jamboree and Business Trick or Treat from 3 p.m. to 4 p.m. He also requested the road be closed from 3p.m. to 8 p.m.

Toby Thomas also wanted council to know that he had received an email from Mr. Bond stating that according to the Ohio Department of Transportation, the village has a right to shut down the road temporarily for parades and other events without ODOT's approval.

Gullett made a motion to adjourn. Steve Ball seconded the motion. Roll call - All ayes; No one opposed.
